## How To Apply

1. Completed application forms & personal essay.
2. **\$50 non-refundable** application fee for applications received on or by March 30<sup>th</sup>.
3. Sealed official transcript of your high school record. If you have received a General Equivalency Diploma (GED), please send a copy of your official scores and/or a copy of your diploma.
4. Sealed official transcript from the registrar's office of each college or post-secondary institution you have attended. In rare cases the registrar will not release transcripts directly to students. If this is the case, please have a copy sent to LICHSORT.
5. Three letters of recommendation (academic and/or Employment) on official letterhead stationary.
6. Photocopies of your proof of citizenship or Permanent Alien Resident card.
7. The enclosed Self-Managed Application Checklist and instructions.
8. Take a Health Occupations Aptitude Examination (given at Long Island College Hospital).

## Admission Procedure

1. When your application is completed, and you have been interviewed, your application will be submitted to the admissions committee for final decision.
2. The final deadline to submit your completed application to LICHSORT is March 30<sup>th</sup>.
3. Once you are accepted, a medical examination and immunization records are required.
